



Geneva ABC Minutes

When: December 7, 2021 meeting, 6:30 PM

Minutes:

A motion was made by John Metzler to accept the minutes from the November 2, 2021 Geneva ABC meeting. Andy Tetlow seconded. All approved.

Correspondence:

CAF check donation of \$14.00. Letter from IRS requesting tax documents which was completed by Jeff.

Financial Report:

Jeff Griffiths presented the October and November finance reports. These reports did not include the proceeds from the doughnut fundraiser or the holiday Donate and Paint. Current balance is approximately \$6000.00. Andy reported that there is nearly \$700 in the PayPal account in which he will transfer to the ABC Lakeview Federal Credit Union account. Jeff requested a PayPal transaction report and Andy said that he would look into providing one. Amber inquired about the doughnut expense for the Middle School Awards ceremony. Jeff said that he donated the cost of the doughnuts. April made a motion to accept the financial report and Amber seconded. All approved.

Sip-N-Paint Review:

There were 43 attendees. The beverage cost was \$228 which was split between Heather Holodniak and the ABC. There were 3 baskets raffled: Springhill basket, dancing Santa Metzler basket, and a lottery basket. Total profits from the event was approximately \$1000. Springhill provided a nice venue and was easy to work with. However, beverage costs are increasing and should be noted for planning any future event. Amber sent event pictures for Andy to post. Jeff remarked that this event expanded our organization's reach. The event was agreed to be a success and that the prospects that future donate and paint events are even better.
